Zoe Mathews -High School

Zoe will graduate from Mountain Island Charter School on May 25, 2023. She will attend North Carolina State University in the fall of 2023, majoring in Biochemistry. She wants to become an epidemiologist. The COVID-19 pandemic sparked an interest in infectious diseases – something she never before considered. She became fascinated with how COVID-19 spread, the economic and social impacts of it, the political responses to it and the development of treatments and vaccines. She is not certain exactly what she wants to research in this field, but definitely wants to help prevent and/or lessen the impact future pandemics.

Zachary (Zac) McDonald is graduating from Hawthorne Military and Global Leadership Academy, a CMS magnet school. He is completing the Public Safety and Law Enforcement track. He will graduate as a Captain in the Army JROTC program where he's been in Color Guard for 4 years, commanded the drill team for 2 years, and has earned numerous ribbons and medals for service and performance. Zac has also participated in CMPD's Explorer program for 4 years, where he's learned the basics of law enforcement, participated in their community service events, and gained practical experience in being a police officer. In the Fall, he will attend CPCC and major in Criminal Justice. He's then hoping to attend UNCC to complete his Bachelor's degree. After that he will apply to the CMPD Police Academy with hopes of one day being a K-9 Officer. Zac enjoys woodworking, welding, and scuba diving during his non-student hours.

Amelia Krebs - Associate's Degree

Amelia will graduate in May, 2023 with an Associates Degree in General Studies in Art from Southwest Virginia Community College. In the fall, she plans to attend the College of History and Interdisciplinary Studies at Norfolk State University.

Alexis Tyler - Bachelor's Degree

Graduates from University of North Carolina at Greensboro with Bachelors in Business Administration with a concentration in Business Studies.

Max Sudderth - Bachelor's Degree

Heather Hall Ramsey - Doctor's Degree

L. Heather Hall Ramsey will graduate from the University of North Carolina at Charlotte on May 12, 2023, as a Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership. For her dissertation, she researched how K-12 classroom teachers educate their students on responsible internet and social media use. This is her fourth degree from Charlotte, where she previously graduated with a BA in Elementary Education ('05), and master's degrees in Reading Education ('09) and Learning, Design and Technology ('16). She currently works at The Fletcher School, a school for students with learning differences such as dyslexia and ADHD. She serves as the Director of Educational Technology and supports teachers in the integration of technology in the classroom. She also teaches online courses in the Learning, Design and Technology department at UNC Charlotte.
